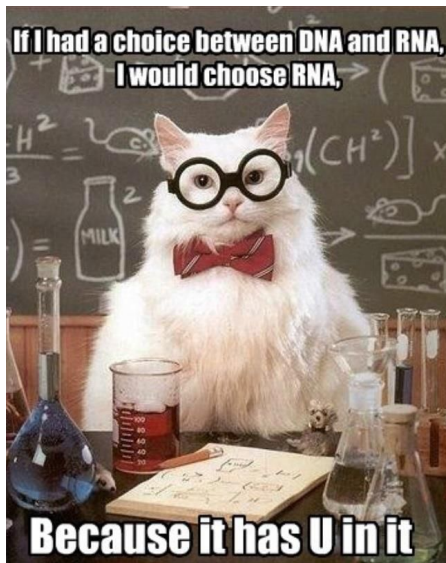


7.345 - Peptides and Nucleosides: Structures, Synthesis and Therapeutic Strategies

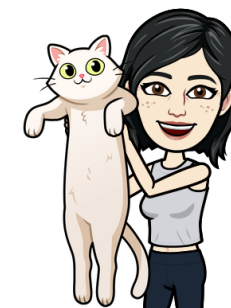
